ENTRY TO THE HALL £3

EXHIBITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read carefully:

The completion of an entry form implies an express understanding that the exhibitor accepts all the rules listed below as binding and final, and any breach of these rules will render the exhibitor liable to be disqualified and to forfeit all entrance fees.

1. Law:- All exhibitors and exhibits must comply with the current Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981 and licence WLF100094. Species not listed on Schedules must comply with General Licence conditions on WML/L14(exhibition) and WML/L18(sale) to be accompanied with Proof of Breeding documents. Any Bird Found to be incorrectly ringed or contravening the Laws will be removed from the hall immediately and forfeit any entrance fees, prize money or specials it may have won.

2. Entry Fees:- Entry fees must be sent with the entry. Entry fees will be forfeited if any exhibit has not arrived at the exhibition hall before the final times for staging.

3. Specials:- Classes are open to all fanciers, not just club members, but all special prizes are confined to N.B.B. & M.C. members only.

4. Food & Water:- All exhibits must be provided with an adequate supply of food for the duration of the show. All necessary utensils fitted to enable the stewards to clean & replenish.

5. Loss:- The show promoters will not be responsible under any circumstances for loss or damage sustained by exhibits or exhibitors and their property, nor any consequential expenses for any cause whatsoever, whether these be sustained on the way to or during, or returning from the exhibition.

6. Mules & Hybrids:- Birds in the mule and Hybrid classes need not be ringed if bred from schedule 3 parents. Miniature mules are those bred from very small varieties of canaries.

7. Hardbills:- All birds in Hardbill classes must be ringed with the British Bird Council's closed rings or I.O.A. closed rings. C.O.M. ringed birds will only be accepted if the exhibitor provides a photocopy of the D.O.E. exemption Licence for the bird with the entry form.

8. Softbills:- All birds in Softbill classes must be ringed with the British Bird Council's closed rings or I.O.A. closed rings. C.O.M. ringed birds will only be accepted if the exhibitor provides a photocopy of the D.O.E. exemption Licence for the bird with the entry form.

9. Unflighted:- Birds entered into unflighted classes must be rung with the correct "Current Year" rings.

10. Northern Species :- All Northern birds, plus their Mules & Hybrids (including Northern goldfinch mules), must be shown in Northern classes and will only be eligible to compete for Northern Specials.

11. Sales:- Birds offered for sale may only be entered into the Sales Classes. Where birds are offered for sale, the price does not include the cage. For British birds, Mules and Hybrids only species listed in the show classes are accepted in sales classes and all other rules apply. Only official N.B.B. & M.C. boxes will be allowed to be taken out of the hall. Sales will commence once the show opens.

12. Novice:- A novice can exhibit in the novice classes for a maximum of five calendar years and will then automatically become a champion.

Read carefully new rules from Natural England

Wildlife and Countryside Act

1. Only Birds which are listed in Schedule 3 part 1 and Non-Schedule that have been bred in captivity may be competitively exhibited. Providing that they are ringed in accordance with the regulations made by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
2. Birds must have been bred in captivity and ringed with a closed ring. A bird shall not be treated as bred in captivity unless its parents were lawfully in captivity when the egg from which it hatched was laid.
3. Only BBC, IOA, DOE or COM rings will be accepted, provided they are accompanied with the necessary licences

Natural England General Licences

Users of General Licences should make themselves fully aware of conditions of the licence they use. Copies of General Licences can be obtained by post from Natural England, Block A Government Buildings, Coley Avenue, Coley Park, reading RG1 6DT or can be accessed on website www.naturalengland.org.uk

Note Schedule 3 part 1 species not ringed in accordance with ringing regulations must be individually licensed by Natural England if they are to be offered for sale or competitively shown. Application form link:

General Licence WML/GEN L14 permits the competitive showing of species not listed on Schedule 3 part 1 subject to conditions of this licence. **Note** proof of breeding documentation is a condition of this licence **and must** accompany the birds.

General Licence WML/GEN L15 permits sale and competitive showing of Mealy Redpoll (*Carduelis flammea flammea*) provided it is ringed with size C ring issued by B.B.C. or I.O.A. **Note:** documentation **is not now** a requirement of this licence.

General Licence WML/GEN L18 permits sale of species not listed on Schedule 3 part 1 provided conditions of the licence are met. **Note** proof of breeding documentation is a condition of this licence **and must** accompany the birds.

13. Juvenile (Early Bird Club):-A juvenile is an exhibitor between the ages of eight and sixteen years who has not yet competed in any other section in an Open Show. Junior awards and specials will only be given to birds exhibited in Junior classes. A junior may if they wish exhibit in a higher status, but will not then be eligible for any Junior awards or Specials. Once having done so, they cannot revert back.

14. Partnership:-Any two names on an entry form will constitute a partnership.

15. Resident Status: - Where two exhibitors reside at the same address and both exhibit British Birds they must exhibit in the higher status of either one, Junior status being the only exception.

16. Status:- Any exhibitor can only exhibit in one status. This rule also applies to Juniors.

17. Disqualification:- The Judge, whose decision is final, shall decide if any bird is wrongly classed, ineligible due to the nationality of the species, has drawn, stained or trimmed plumage, insufficiently trained or is in any way dishonestly shown. The Judge shall mark the cage label accordingly, and any such exhibit is automatically disqualified from the competition. It is the responsibility of the Show Manager to decide if the exhibit should be removed from the staging.

18. Protests:- Any exhibitor wishing to make a protest must do so in writing. The protest must be handed to the Show Secretary during the Show by the person making the protest along with a £5 deposit. The protest will then be considered by the committee, whose decision will be final and binding. Only if the protest is upheld will the deposit be refunded.

19. Committee: - The exhibition promoters committee will deal with all matters arising out of the exhibition, whether provided for in the foregoing or not, and their decision is final and absolute.

20. Early Lifting: - Any application for lifting of birds prior to the published lifting time on Sunday is entirely at the discretion of the Show Manager. The Show Managers decision is final and absolute.

21. Visitors:- The only people allowed within the hall during the staging and judging of the exhibition are those duly appointed by the officials. The committee has the right to refuse entry to the Exhibition Hall to anyone they consider their presence is likely to lead to a disturbance. Photographic & video equipment may only be used in the show hall when authorised by the show manager. No member of the public may take photographs or videos of birds without the owner's permission. Dogs will not be allowed into the hall.

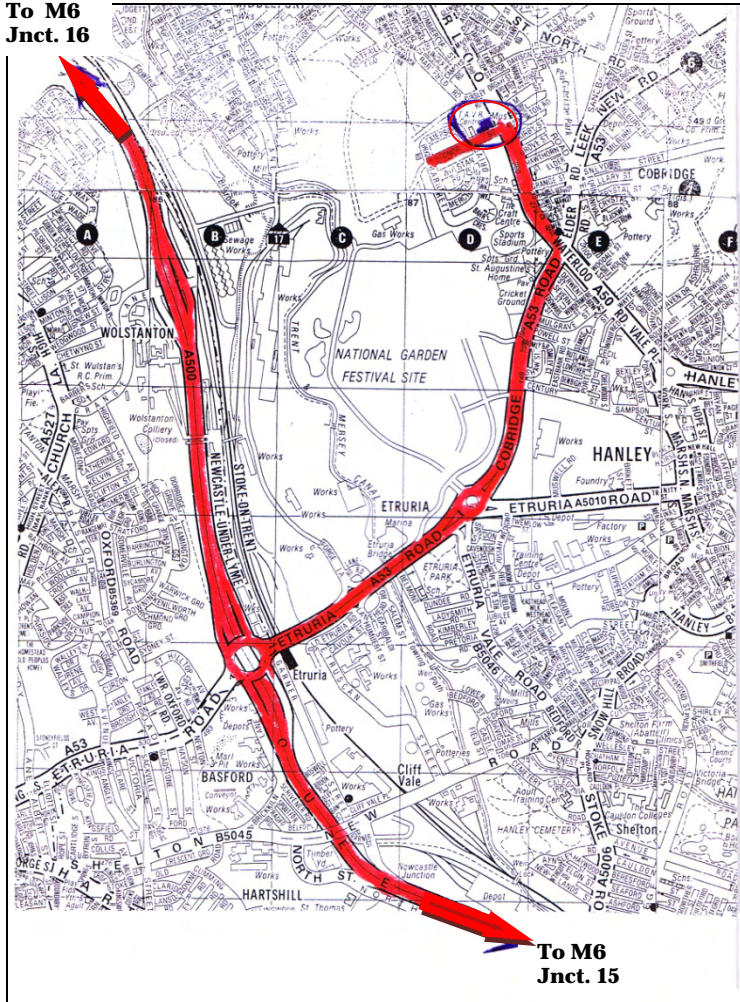
22. Judges: - are not permitted to exhibit at the show.

23. Conditions: - It is a condition of accepting an entry that any contravention of a criminal law, ab inito, the contract with the organisers rendering the entry null and void, in the event of an entry being in breach of this condition the organisers, their servants will contend that they are not and never have been in possession of the entry in question and are not 'showing' the entry in question. The exhibitor remains in possession of the entry at all times and 'shows' the entry.

24. Cages: - All exhibits shall be staged in the Minimum Standard Show Cage for the species (or larger).
Note: Only Siskins and Lesser Redpolls will be accepted in British No.1 cages.
