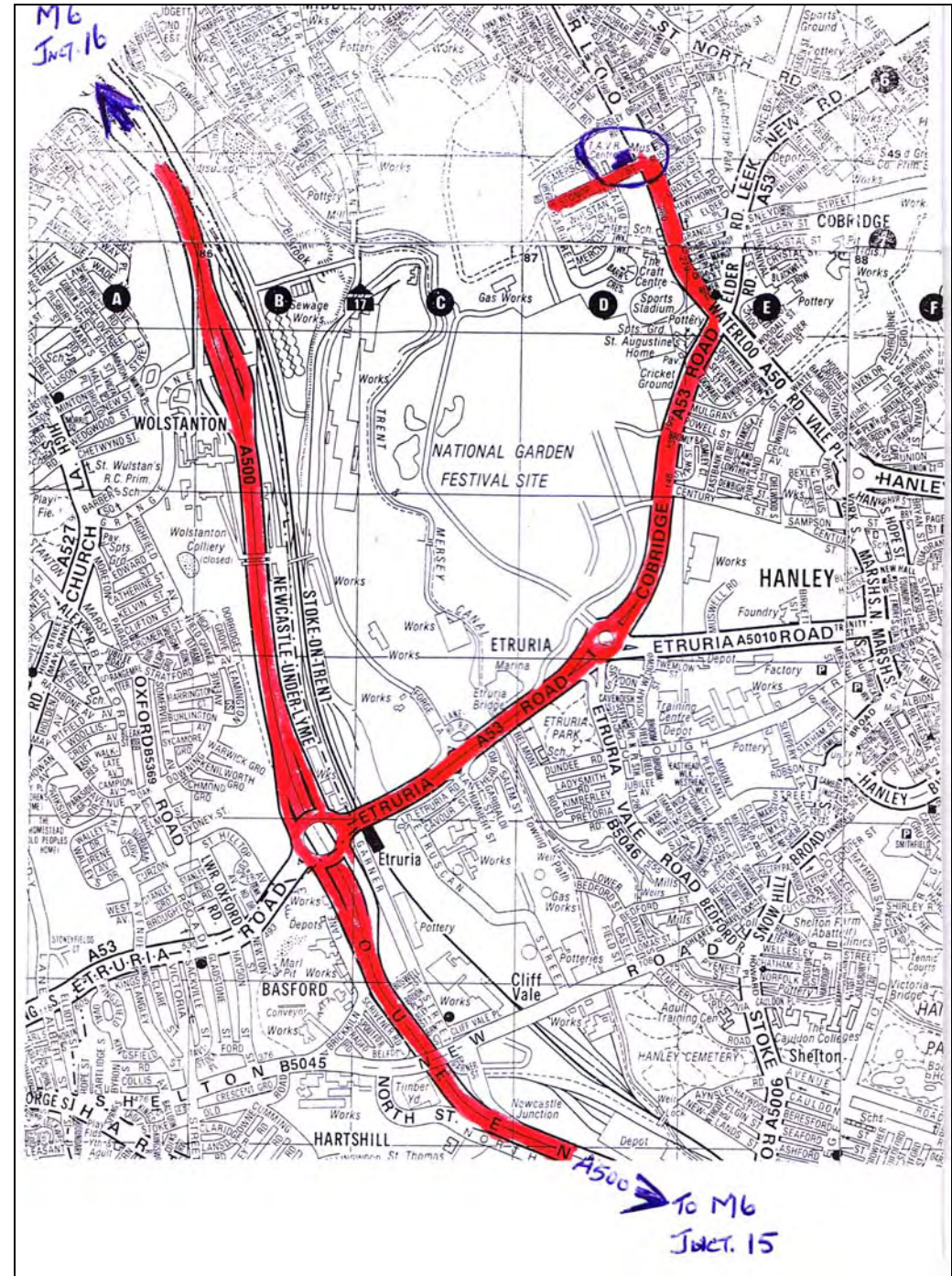

Directions To The Show Hall.

From North: Leave the M6 at Junction 16 onto the A500. After approximately 8miles turn left at the junction with the A53 signposted **City Centre/Leek and Warrington. Stay in the Right hand lane**, heading for **Leek**, on the flyover over the roundabout, then keep in **Left** hand lane to traffic lights at Major cross road. Turn **Left**, signposted **Warrington** then through next traffic lights to **TA Centre** on **Left** after approximately half a mile. Turn **Left** into **Stonor Street**, entrance is 100yds on the **Right**.

From South: Leave the M6 at Junction 15 onto the A500. Drive over the flyover and stay on the A500 through to the junction with the A53 signposted **City Centre/Leek and Warrington**. Turn **Right** and then follow directions above from **Stay in Right Hand Lane...**

From Derbyshire, Yorkshire etc: Take the A50 signposted **Uttoxeter and Stoke on Trent**. At the junction with A500 (just after passing the **Britannia Stadium**) turn **Right** and travel through to the junction with the A53. Then follow the directions above from **Stay in Right hand lane...**

13. Partnerships:

Any two names on an entry form constitute a partnership.

14. Novice:

An exhibitor can only exhibit in Novice Classes for 5 years, then they will automatically be promoted to the Champion Classes.

15. Juvenile:

A Juvenile is an exhibitor between the ages of 6 and 17 who has not competed in any other section of an open show. Junior awards and Specials will only be given to birds within this class. A juvenile may, if they wish, be eligible to exhibit in a higher status, but can not then revert back to Juvenile status.

16. Status:

Any exhibitor can only exhibit in one status. This also applies to Juveniles.

17. Protests:

Any exhibitor wishing to make a protest, must make it in writing to the Show Secretary during the show and pay a £5 deposit. The protest will then be considered by the Committee whose decision will be final and binding. If the protest is sustained, the deposit of £5 will be refunded.

18. Committee:

The Exhibition Promoters Committee will deal with all matters arising out of the exhibition, whether in the foregoing or not, and their decision is final and absolute.

19. Judges:

Judges are not allowed to exhibit at any show that they judge at.

20. Visitors:

The Committee have the right to refuse entry to anyone to the exhibition hall if they consider that their presence is likely to lead to a disturbance. Dogs will not be allowed in the exhibition hall under any circumstances. No photographic equipment is to be used in the exhibition hall unless authorised by the Show Manager.

21. Conditions:

It is a condition of accepting an entry that any contravention of the criminal law, ab initio, the contract with the organisers rendering the null and void. In the event of any entry being in breach of this condition the organisers, their servants and agents will contend that they are not and never have been in possession of the entry in question and are not 'showing' the entry in question. The exhibitor remains in possession of the entry at all times and 'shows' the entry.

22. Unethical:

An exhibitor shall not offer or receive accommodation or hospitality to or from a Judge prior to completion of judging.

Please Read Carefully New Rule from Natural England Exhibition Rules and Regulations.

1. Entries:

The completion of the entry form implies an express understanding that the exhibitor accepts these rules as binding and final, and any breach of the rules will render the exhibitor to be disqualified and to forfeit all entrance fees.

2. Law:**

All exhibitors and exhibits must comply with the current Wildlife and Countryside Act, 1981 and licence WLF 199094. Species not listed on Schedule must comply with General Licence conditions on WML/L14(Exhibition) and WML/L18(Sale) to be accompanied with Proof of Breeding documents

3. Cages:

All exhibits shall be staged in the minimum standard show cages for the species or larger. The colour recommended being **Brolac Georgian Green.**

4. Food:

All exhibits must be provided with all necessary utensils fitted to enable stewards to clean and replenish, and an adequate supply of food for the duration of the show.

5. Bona-Fide:

All exhibits to be the **Bona-Fide** property of the exhibitor.

6. Entry Fees:

Must be sent with the entry form, which must be signed in the appropriate places. Entry fees will be forfeited if any exhibit does not arrive at the exhibition hall before the final time of judging.

7. Loss:

The show promoters will not be responsible, under any circumstances for the loss or damage sustained to the exhibits or exhibitors and their property, nor any consequential expenses for any cause whatsoever, whether these be sustained either on the way to, during, at or returning from the show.

8. Wrong Class:

The Judge, whose decision is final, shall decide if any bird is wrong classed, or if any bird is ineligible due to the nationality of the species. They will mark the cage accordingly, and any such exhibit will be disqualified from the show.

9. Dishonest:

The Judge, whose decision is final, shall decide if any bird has drawn, stained or trimmed plumage, or is in any way dishonestly shown. They will mark the cage accordingly. Any such exhibit is automatically disqualified and will be removed from the exhibition hall forthwith.

10. Untrained:

The Judge, whose decision is final, shall decide if any bird is insufficiently trained. They will mark the cage accordingly. Any such exhibit is automatically disqualified and will be removed from the exhibition hall forthwith.

11. Sale of Birds:

British Birds will be sold at the exhibition.

12. Resident Status:

Where two exhibitors reside at the same address and both show British Birds, they must exhibit in the higher status of either one. The exception being Junior Exhibitors.

Read carefully new rules from Natural England

Wildlife and Countryside Act

1. Only Birds which are listed in Schedule 3 part 1 and Non-Schedule that have been bred in captivity may be competitively exhibited. Providing that they are ringed in accordance with the regulations made by the Secretary of State for the Environment.
2. Birds must have been bred in captivity and ringed with a closed ring. A bird shall not be treated as bred in captivity unless its parents were lawfully in captivity when the egg from which it hatched was laid.
3. Only BBC, IOA, DOE or COM rings will be accepted, provided they are accompanied with the necessary licences

Natural England General Licences

Users of General Licences should make themselves fully aware of conditions of the licence they use. Copies of General Licences can be obtained by post from Natural England, Block A Government Buildings, Coley Avenue, Coley Park, Reading RG1 6DT or can be accessed on website www.naturalengland.org.uk

Note Schedule 3 part 1 species not ringed in accordance with ringing regulations must be individually licensed by Natural England if they are to be offered for sale or competitively shown. Application form link <http://www.naturalengland.org.uk/ourwork/regulation/wildlife/licences/applicationforms.aspx>

General Licence WML/GEN L14 permits the competitive showing of species not listed on Schedule 3 part 1 subject to conditions of this licence. **Note** proof of breeding documentation is a condition of this licence **and must** accompany the birds.

General Licence WML/GEN L15 permits sale and competitive showing of Mealy Redpoll (*Carduelis flammea flammea*) provided it is ringed with size C ring issued by B.B.C. or I.O.A. **Note** documentation **is not now** a requirement of this licence.

General Licence WML/GEN L18 permits sale of species not listed on Schedule 3 part 1 provided conditions of the licence are met. **Note** proof of breeding documentation is a condition of this licence **and must** accompany the birds.
